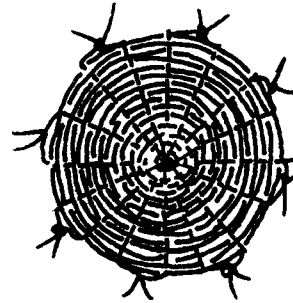


Circle Weaving

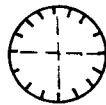
Materials:

1. (1) paper plate, any size
2. yarn, all colors and weights
3. scissors
4. needle or wire

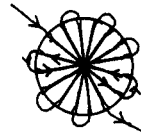
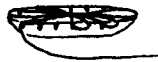


Steps:

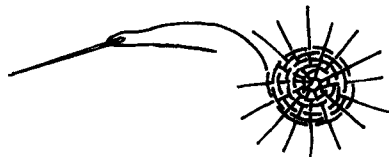
1. Cut an uneven number of evenly spaced slits around the edge of the paper plate. Cut the slits so they point to the middle and are about $\frac{1}{2}$ " long.



2. String paper plate for weaving by running a piece of yarn from one slit to the one directly across, through slit, under, and come up through the next slit. Remember to always cross the center.



3. Start weaving in the center and weave round and round until the circle is as large as desired. To add other pieces of yarn, tie new piece to the end of the old with a knot.



4. To finish, cut the loops and tie 'neighbors' together. This is easier to do if the plate is turned over and only two loops at a time are cut. This will also free the weaving from the plate.
