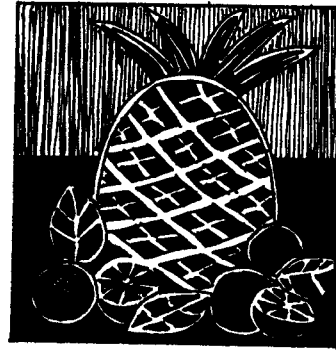


# Crayon Scratch

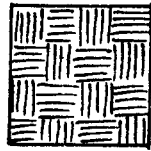
## Materials:

1. piece of lightweight cardboard or chipboard
2. old, peeled crayons
3. a sharp, pointed tool such as a toothpick, tapestry needle or something similar
4. newspapers
5. thick black tempera paint mixed with liquid soap and a paint brush



## Steps:

1. Put newspaper to protect desk from crayon scraps.
2. Color the whole surface of the lightweight cardboard or chipboard with many colors. Press firmly, making the colors bright and solid. Color squares, circles or wavy lines.



3. When all the coloring is completed, paint over the entire paper with the thick black tempera paint mixed with liquid soap.
4. When the paint is dry, use the pointed tools to scratch out a planned picture or design. Create texture by using many shapes and design.

## Hints:

- Remember to keep the paper in the middle of a piece of newspaper so the crayon scraps and paint chips will not go on the floor or this could be a very messy project.
